September 6-8, 2022

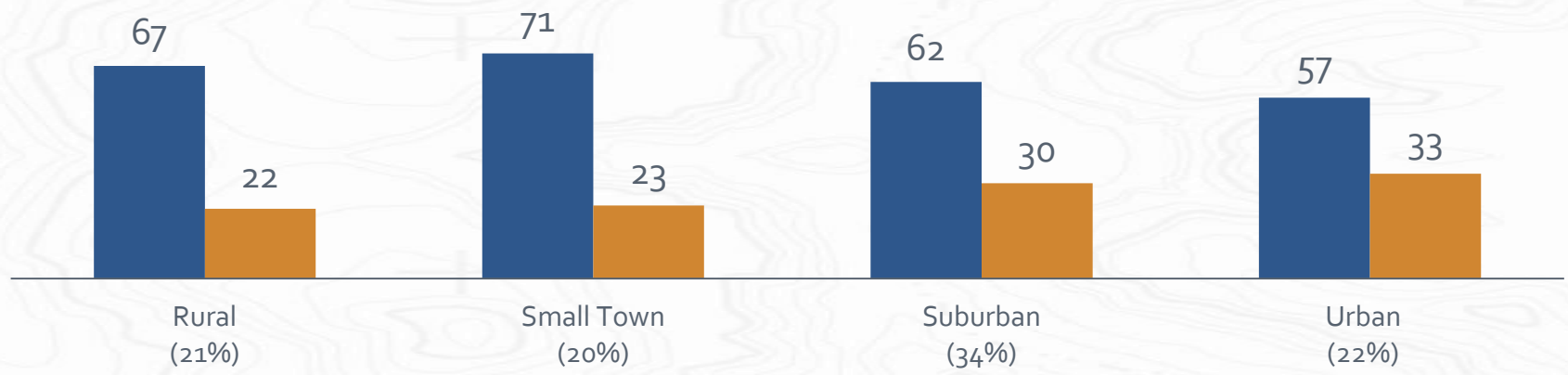
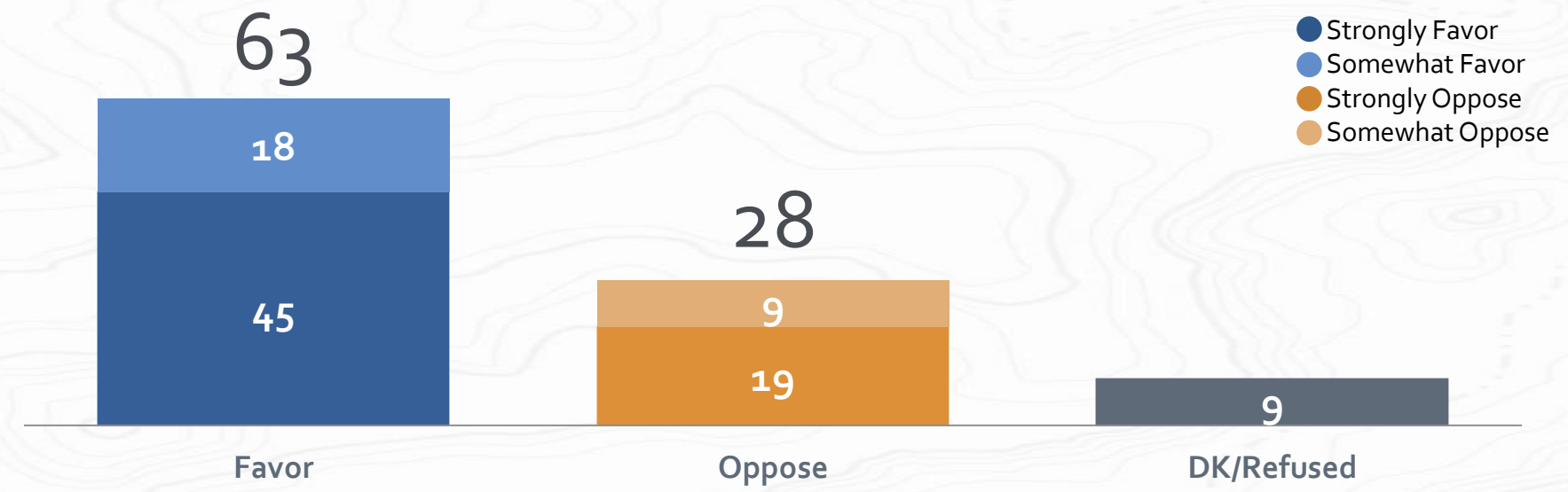
The following survey was conducted for the Invest in Education Coalition by OnMessage Inc. Telephone interviews were conducted on September 6-8, 2022.

This survey consists of 1,000 likely voters and was stratified to reflect historical turnout. The margin of error for this survey is +/- 3.1%.



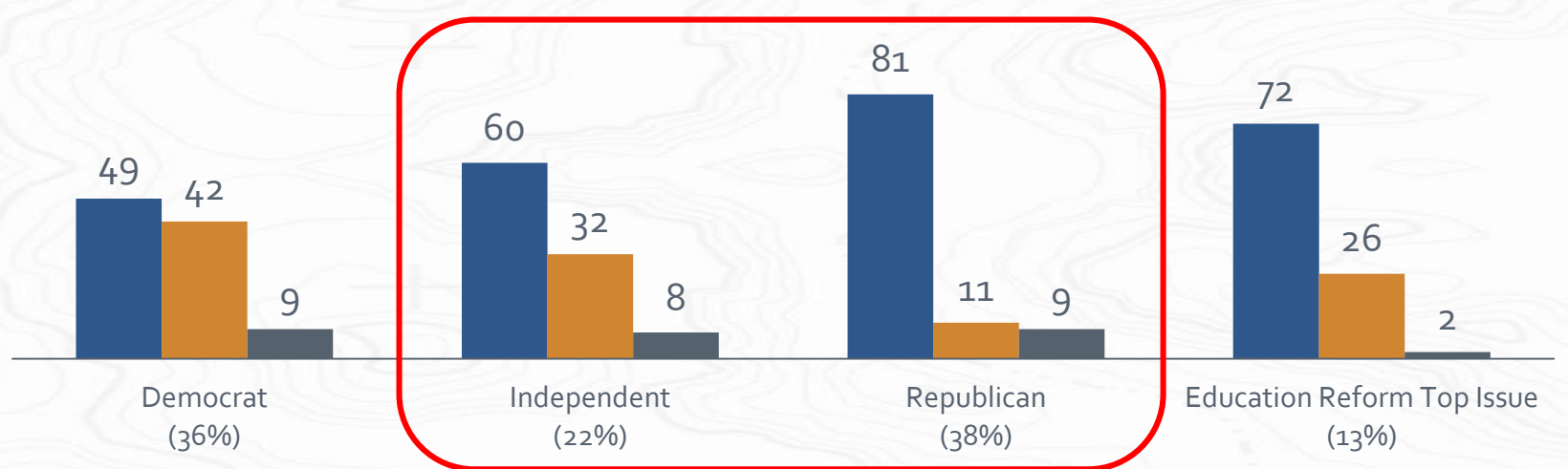
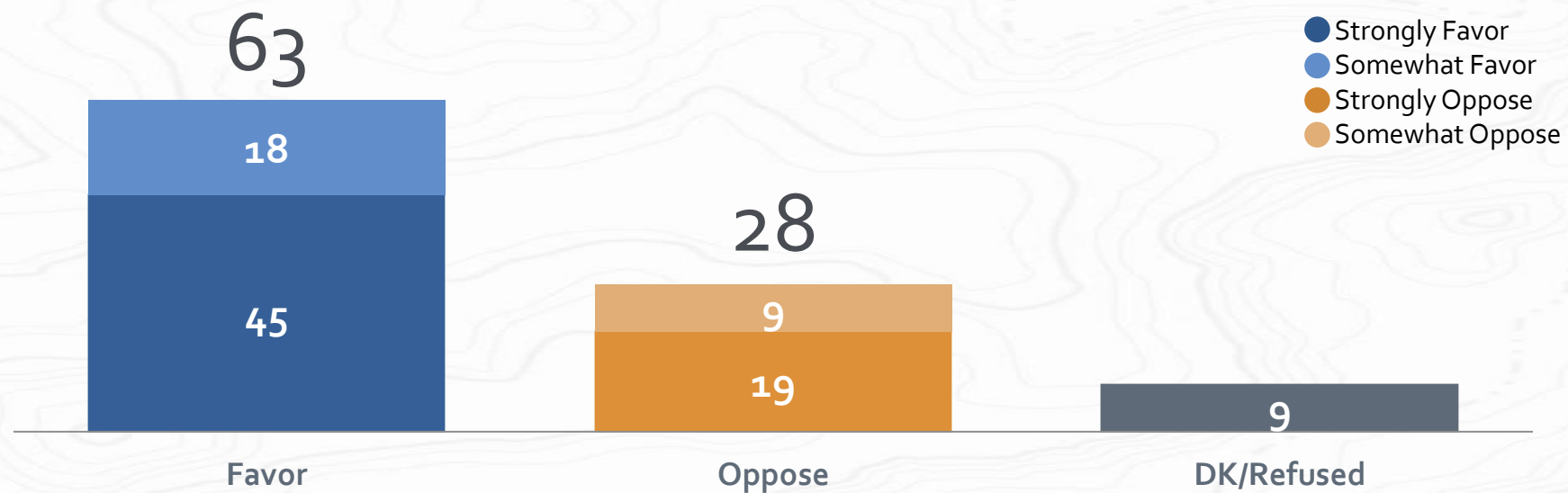

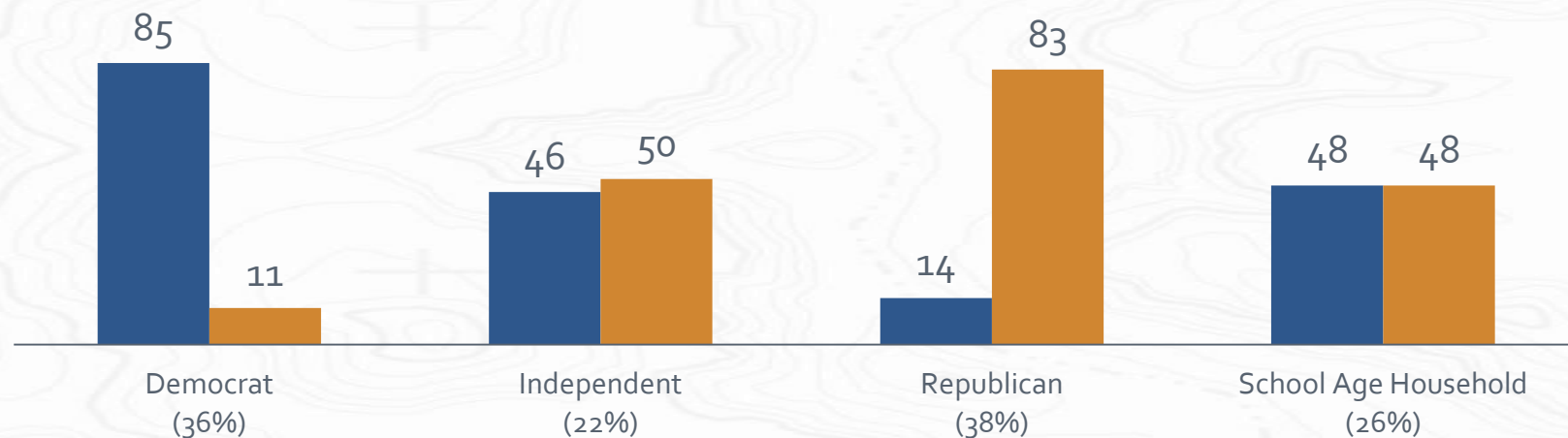
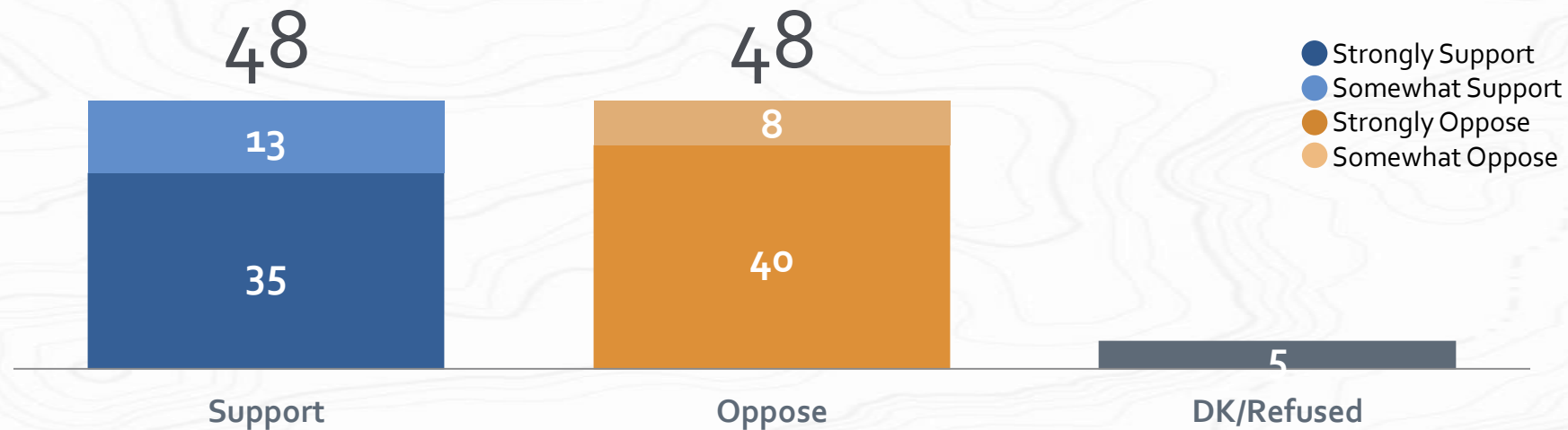


School Age Household (26%)

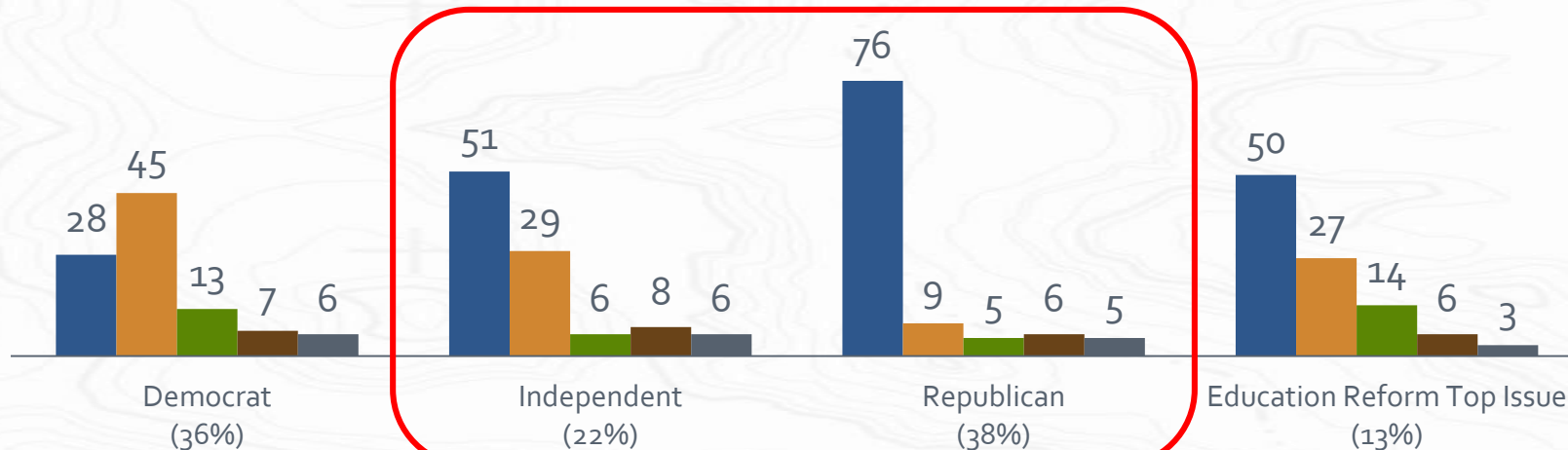
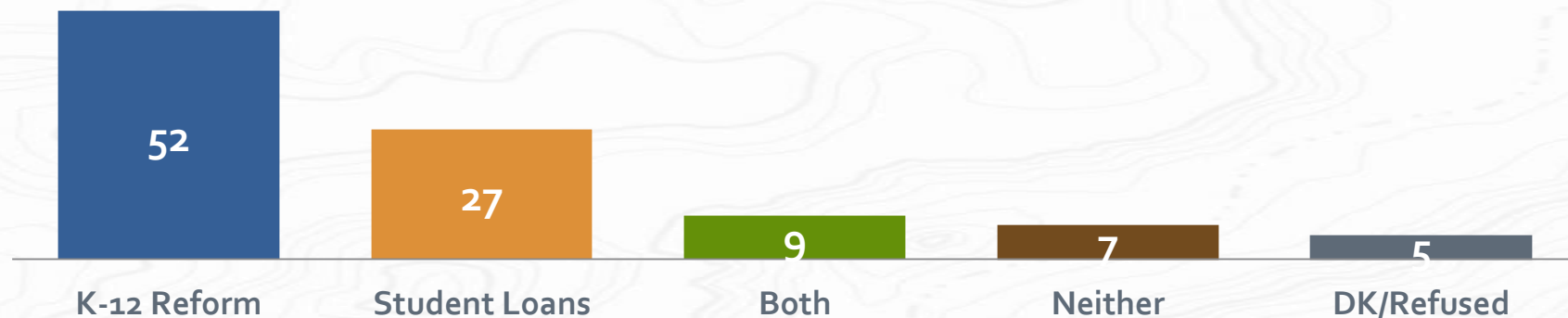
